Epiphany is the first commemoration for the Holy Three Kings, who met the Lord and brought Him gifts a few days after His birth. It marks the start of the "Epiphany" season, consisting of manifestations, and the first (particularly important for Catholics) when Christians like Three Kings Day, are, and also through the Three Kings Day, are called to believe in and worship the true God.
